# IVUSBC Senior Championship Rules

1. Tournament is open to all USBC certified bowlers who are 50 years of age or older, and members of the Imperial Valley USBC Association.
2. Entering averages to be used in this tournament shall be as follows:
  - a. Highest 2021/2022 book average of 21 or more games as posted on bowl.com
  - b. Highest 2020/2021 book average of 21 or more games as posted on bowl.com
  - c. Highest current average of 21 or more games in the same league as of March 1, 2023
  - d. If none of the above, bowler will be assigned an average of 220.
  - e. Failure to report correct average (before the end of the 1st game) shall result in disqualification.
3. Handicap will be 80% of 220. Prize ratio shall be 1 – 5 team, 1 – 5 doubles & singles, 1 – 7 for all events, or better, depending on the amount of entries.
4. Multiple participation: Teams consist of three bowlers. Bowlers may enter team and doubles event 2 times, however, not more than 2 players may bowl more than twice in team event and may not bowl with the same partner twice. Bowlers may only bowl singles and all once. A bowler 1st doubles event requires them to bowl singles also. A bowler who bowls multiple doubles will only pay for singles once. When a bowler participates more than once in Team and Doubles, the first appearance in each shall count toward all events. All events includes the nine game total from bowling the 1st appearance in team, doubles, and singles.
5. Dress Code Rule: All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. The Tournament committee shall determine the validity of any complaints.
6. There will be no practicing on the assigned lanes 2 hours prior to bowling the tournament.
7. There shall be no changes made after entry has been accepted, unless the changes are made by the Team captain.
8. Bowlers must check in at least thirty (30) minutes before squad time.
9. Entries must be filled out completely and legibly for all bowlers. Please print all information. Checks should be made out to Imperial Valley USBC.
10. Subs are allowed, as long as tournament rules are followed, in Team and Doubles only. The sub shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee or prize money. If an entrant is late for a doubles event, the entrant present shall bowl their singles first. If the partner has not arrived by the time the doubles event has started, and a sub has not been found, the entrant present shall be permitted to bowl their games in doubles to qualify for all events. All events include the nine game total from bowling the 1st appearance in team, doubles, and singles. If any entrant in any event is late, the bowler shall starting the frame being bowled, there will be no making up frames.
11. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Protest must be filed in writing within 24 hours. After the Tournament rules have been adopted, they may be changed prior to the start of the Tournament by two thirds vote of the Board of Directors. The adopted rules must not conflict with USBC Rules.
12. The Tournament Director has the right to accept entries past the deadline in order to even out any squad.
13. All spectators, including children, shall be required to stay off the lanes, behind the tables.
14. If not specifically covered in these local association tournament rules, USBC tournament rules shall apply.
